FRONTIER AIRLINES ANNOUNCES NEW NONSTOP FLIGHTS TO PHILADELPHIA WITH FARES FROM \$19

Three flights per week begin May 16

MILWAUKEE (February 7, 2024) – Ultra-low fare carrier <u>Frontier Airlines</u> today announced plans to add nonstop service between Milwaukee Mitchell International Airport and Philadelphia International Airport (PHL) this spring. The flights begin May 16 and will operate on Sundays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays on an Airbus A320 aircraft.

"Today's announcement from Frontier provides another option for Milwaukee travelers to enjoy Philadelphia's rich history," Airport Director Brian Dranzik said. "From Independence Hall where the Declaration of Independence and U.S. Constitution were signed, to the famous Philly cheesesteak restaurants, there's something for everyone in Philadelphia."

With today's announcement, Frontier will offer low-cost nonstop flights to six destinations from Milwaukee, including Denver, Fort Myers, Las Vegas, and Orlando. Last month, Frontier also announced new nonstop service from Milwaukee to Raleigh-Durham beginning May 16.
