FLY NONSTOP FROM MKE TO SARASOTA, FLORIDA THIS SPRING
Southwest Airlines adding seasonal spring break service to Sarasota

MILWAUKEE (December 12, 2022) – Southwest Airlines is adding Sarasota, Florida to its growing list of cities served nonstop from Milwaukee this spring. Southwest Airlines will offer daily nonstop service between Milwaukee Mitchell International (MKE) Airport and Sarasota Bradenton International Airport (SRQ) from March 9, 2023 through April 10, 2023 for the busy spring break travel season.
