A petition resolution requesting state financial assistance has been filed by Milwaukee County with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Aeronautics to help carry out the following development at Lawrence J. Timmerman Airport, Milwaukee, Wisconsin:

Extension of the primary runway by 600 feet by constructing an additional 300 feet at each end of Runway 15L-33R. Additionally, the associated parallel taxiway will be extended and drainage improvements will be made in conformance with Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) Chapter 13, Surface and Storm Water Rules.

This project does not include wetland impacts and does not include floodplain impacts.

All interested persons are notified of the availability of a Preliminary Environmental Assessment of the effects of the proposed improvements.
