

The project is being undertaken to bring the runway safety areas at General Mitchell International Airport into compliance with Federal Aviation Administration design standards. The project will involve grading and clearing the safety areas at the ends of Runways 1L/19R and 7R/25L. The required safety area dimensions for each runway end are a width of 500-feet and a length of 1000-feet. The project includes relocating Airport service roads and a portion of a City of Milwaukee road, constructing a tunnel on an existing County Highway alignment, removing pavement and adding new pavement to maintain existing runway lengths and airport operational capabilities. Navigational aids will also be relocated as part of this project. All ground disturbance will occur within the current Airport boundary.
