

UNITED AIRLINES ADDS NONSTOP SERVICE TO TWO FLORIDA DESTINATIONS Daily service to Tampa and Fort Myers begins December 17

**MILWAUKEE (August 12, 2020)** – United Airlines today announced plans to add nonstop flights between Milwaukee and two popular Florida destinations this winter. The new daily service to Fort Myers and Tampa begins on December 17. The flights will be operated with full-size Airbus A319 aircraft, featuring in-flight Wi-Fi and First, Economy Plus, and Economy seating. Tickets are now available for purchase on united.com and the United mobile app.
