At General Mitchell International Airport

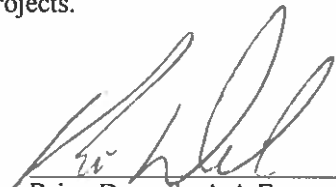
- 1) Vehicle Movement Area Transponders Project
